BVSD\BVEOP Negotiations Update 4/23

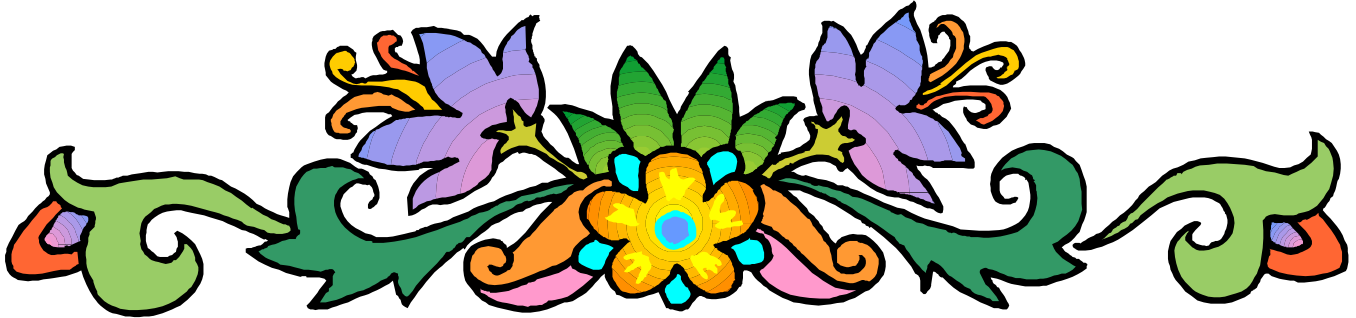
Representatives from the BVSD Board of Education and the BVEOP have met for five sessions so far in the negotiations process. The group is utilizing an interest-based problem solving model in discussing the issues identified.

Topics discussed and/or identified to date include:

- Involvement of BVEOP for position work year changes or reorganization changes
- Changes in Personal Leave to allow for unlimited accrual with Personal Leave requests requiring supervisor approval
- Discussion of re-activating the BVEOP Advisory Council as per section F-1
- Discussion of language change for Vacation Leave carry-over
- Request to align evaluation forms with revised job descriptions
- Ensuring that hours worked over 40 hours per week are compensated
- Request to review the current calculation and distribution of school FTE for Unit D employees
- Clarification of verbiage addressing salary status in a reorganization or reclassification process
- Clarification of verbiage regarding the reduction in force process
- Alignment of language regarding working while on leave from the district
- Transfer process and timeline
- Updated language to reflect the self funded benefits program
- Language updates to reflect current nomenclature
- Tuition Reimbursement alignment to current practice
- Compensation

Tentative Agreements:

- ü New language in E-21.1 describing the current health, dental, and life insurance programs
- ü Updating of the title page of the Agreement to reflect BVSD
- ü Additional language to strengthen Section F on Advisory Council to commit to a meeting between BVEOP and the District quarterly for the purpose of communication and problem-solving of issues

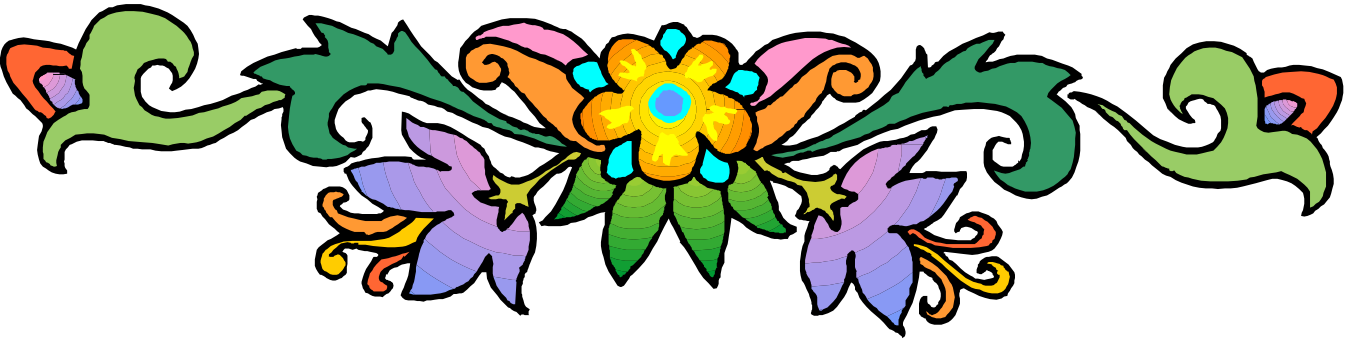
We want to thank all members of BVEOP for the dedication and commitment that you demonstrate day in and day out.
