First Aid/CPR Training Requirements**

School District policy requires that certain groups of employees and volunteers obtain and maintain Red Cross certification in order to safely attend to injured students and staff. The following information outlines the requirements for training. Please note that Transportation and Community Schools have made provision for training their own staff members.
