COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT IN DECISIONMAKING

Since widespread public participation in school policymaking is one of the best guarantees that community interests will be reflected in the school program, a variety of advisory committees, comprised of citizens of the District, are formed to secure the public's input into improving the educational program. Such committees, under the direction of the Superintendent, make thorough studies of the subjects assigned them, and submit their findings and recommendations to the Board of Education through the Superintendent.
