COMMITMENT TO ACCOMPLISHMENT

In accordance with state law, the Board of Education has approved the following regulations in order to provide the best possible education for all of the children in the School District:

1. The accountability program will be implemented with the help and advice of the professional staff (teachers and administrators) and patrons of the District.
2. To coordinate and speed the complex program, a qualified professional should coordinate the accountability program.
3. The Superintendent or designee will serve as liaison to the District Accountability Committee.
4. To assist in funding evaluation studies so essential to the accountability effort, the District Accountability Committee and administration will seek external funding.
5. To encourage and support accountability efforts in individual schools and in keeping with available resources, the Board of Education will, when possible, provide grants of up to \$1,000 which will be used for special efforts.
6. The administration and the District Accountability Committee will periodically review the accountability policy, regulation, and implementation.
7. To comply with the intent of the law, the District Accountability Committee will encourage the Board to communicate effectively and continuously with the public. Such accountability will serve to strengthen understanding of and support for our public schools and will pay handsome dividends.
