I have had so much fun this winter. It has been a great season. :)

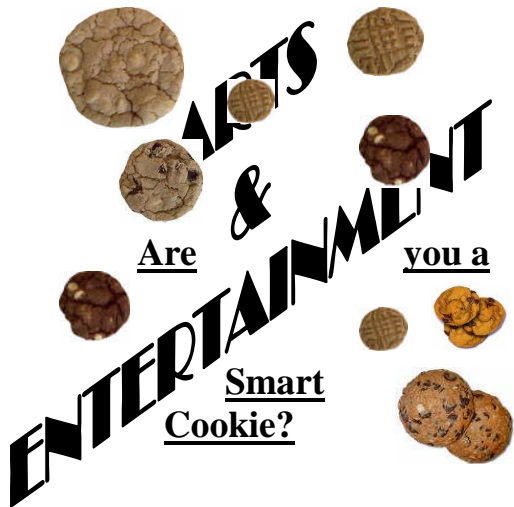


Casey Basketball Players Make Casey Proud
