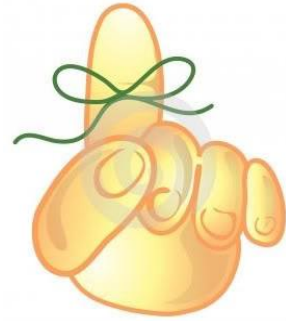
### Wednesday Community Gathering:
