## Goals

- Standardize length of school day by level
$\sqrt{ }$ High school day set at 7.25 hrs. (2019-20)
Align bell times to national research regarding adolescent sleep patterns
$\sqrt{ }$ High school start time adjusted to 8:30 a.m. (2019-20)
- Design an efficient and affordable transportation routing system/schedule to align to the new length of day
- Standardize professional learning time (PLT) to occur outside the school day using a late start model
- Review/revise lunch times to provide students with a full 25 minutes to sit and eat


## Guiding Principles

- Develop a well-balanced day for students and staff
- Consider the needs of elementary, middle, and high schools individually and as a system
- Propose transportation recommendations that are cost-neutral or result in a savings, as much as possible
- Consider employee negotiated agreements in making recommendations


## What is Best for Students

Moving toward an equitable school day

Adjust high school start time to 8:30 or later

- Adjust length of school day to provide uniform instructional time for all students
- 60 minutes of professional learning time outside of school day
- BVEA supported
- Not staff meeting time

## Transportation Cost Saving Options with Equal School Day



Replace school buses with RTD passes for some high schools (COVID delay)


Consolidate stops in neighborhoods (reduce stops overall)

Re-evaluate walk distances to school/bus stops and ride times


Evaluate load counts to identify opportunities to consolidate routes

- Require families to opt-in for bus service (began 20-21)
